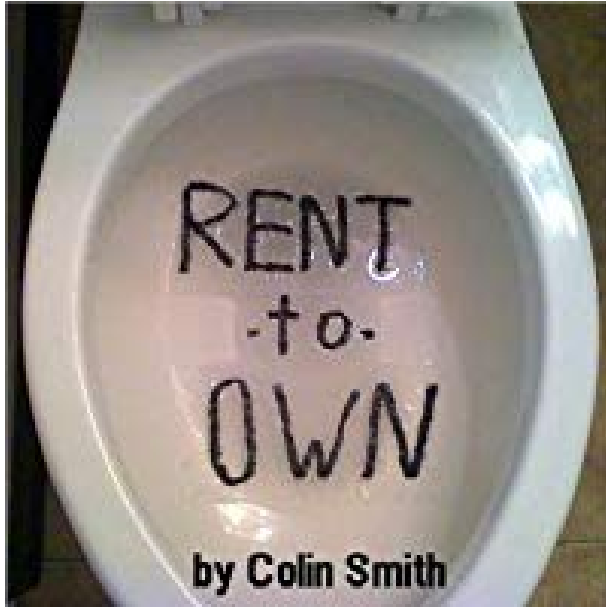


# Rent-to-Own
